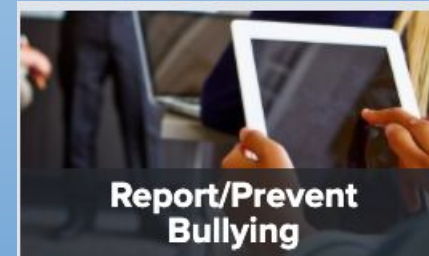

Bullying Prevention and Resources

Bullying Prevention in NUSD

- School staff who witness an act of bullying against a student to immediately interfere to stop the incident when it is safe to do so in accordance with Education Code 234.1.
- Encouraging students to report the incident to their school site administration, a teacher, a counselor, the principal, a compliance officer or any other available staff member
- Encouraging students to be upstanders versus bystanders
