## PTSA ADCP - ART COMPETITION GUIDELINES

**Art Competition Officially Started:** March 11, 2019, Monday

**Art Competition Extended End Date:** **March 25, 2019, Monday**

1. **Eligibility:** Open to all Inderkum High School students.
2. **Entry Fee:** No entry fee required.
3. **Multiple Entries:** A student is allowed a maximum of two (2) entries. To be fair, students who already submitted on the original due date are allowed to submit 1 more entry on the extended date.
4. **Theme: Participants can choose from one of the following themes:**
  - a) Self-Portrait as "Selfies"
  - b) Influences of Social Media in Teenagers
  - c) Bullying/Cyberbullying and its Effects
5. **Art work Description**
  - a) Provide a brief description of your art work and explain what the relevance of the theme is to you (minimum of 4 sentences). Have this typewritten (Font: Arial, Size: 11) and printed together with your information.
6. **Media Requirements:** Any of the following media may be used:
  - a) **Digital:** original digital illustration; photography not allowed
  - b) **Drawing materials:** pen and ink, pencil, colored pencils, charcoal, pastels, markers
  - c) **Paint materials:** watercolor, poster, acrylic
7. **Entry Format:**
  - a) Original artwork needs to be submitted in a format no smaller than 8x10 and no bigger than 11x17.
  - b) Recommended Mixed Media paper size: 9x14 or 11x14
  - c) Digital art needs to be 300dpi resolution and in jpg format. Printing of digital work will be done by PTSA.
  - d) Save your digital image as a .jpg using this file naming: [your last name]\_[theme]\_grade.jpg
  - e) Example: **Taylor\_Self-Portrait as Selfies\_9.jpg**
  - f) File size should be a maximum of 1 MB.
8. **Art contest Rules**
  - a) Artwork may not contain any profanity.
  - b) Artwork can be realistic or abstract.
  - c) You must be the creator of the art and image file you or your approved representative submits for the competition. Your art must be your own original concept and not a copy of anyone else's copyrighted material. (If your image infringes upon another's copyright it will be disqualified.) Upon submitting your work, to this competition, you are solely responsible for any infringement on copyrighted materials.
  - d) Each entry must be labeled with the date, contestant's full name, address, phone number, high school grade level, and e-mail address.
9. **Submission of Entries**
  - a) **Entry deadline is Monday, March 25, 2019. All entries must be submitted no later than 3:30pm at the IHS Administration Office.** Place your art work inside the green bin marked with Submission of Entries. Entries submitted past the allotted time will not be accepted.

10. **Judging criteria:** A selection committee will review artwork submissions based on the following criteria:
  - a) Interpretation of the theme
  - b) Technical skill
  - c) Creativity
  - d) Originality / Conforming to Copyright Law: Any artwork that depicts copyrighted images will be rejected. For example, no artworks depicting characters from television shows, movies, video games, or books will be accepted. All artworks must be original ideas and created entirely by the student.



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- e) Art work description
- f) Conformance to Art Competition Guidelines

**11. Judging and winners**

- a) A selected panel of judges will review entries by theme and medium used.
- b) 3 finalists will be selected from each theme and media.
- c) Finalists will be selected and notified shortly thereafter.
- d) All finalists' artwork will be featured in the IHS Atrium.
- e) All finalists' artwork will be showcased during the school's Open House on March 28 where students, parents, teachers, administrators and all open house guests can vote on their favorite art work.
- f) Winners will be chosen through public voting by the number of tokens they accumulate at the Open House.
- g) Winners will be announced in April – date to be determined.
- h) All participants will receive a certificate of participation.

**12. Awards & Prizes**

- a) **6 Major Awards will be given:**
  - i) Best Art work for the Self-Portrait as "Selfies" (Trophy & \$100)
  - ii) Best Art work for the Influences of Social Media in Teenagers Theme (Trophy & \$100)
  - iii) Best Art work for the Bullying/Cyberbullying and its Effects Theme (Trophy & \$100)
  - iv) Best Media Award: Digital (Certificate and \$50)
  - v) Best Media Award: 1 selected from Drawing Materials (Certificate and \$50)
  - vi) Best Media Award: 1 selected from Paint Materials (Certificate and \$50)
- b) 3 Special recognitions may be given to exceptional art works following closely to the art works that wins the Best Art Work awards (this is only if there are a lot of participants with exceptional work)

**13. Waiver/Disclaimer form.**

- a) All entries/submissions become the property of IHS PTSA.

**14. Waiver/ Disclaimer**

- a) Any and all Entries in the IHS PTSA Art Competition (collectively the "Entries") shall be deemed, and shall remain, the property of IHS PTSA.
